



## Medical Dashboard

HAvBED is a federally-mandated program that requires states to collect and report local hospital available bed data. HAvBED data provides near-real-time electronic nationwide public health situational awareness / hospital available beds for emergencies and disasters. As part of the Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) grant, Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) conducts regular statewide drills to collect HAvBED data.

When you receive a request to update your bed availability, please follow these steps:

- 1.) Log-in to WebEOC using “2019 GCRAC Monthly Login Check”
- 2.) Select Medical Dashboard from the blue boards box in the left-hand corner
- 3.) On the Main Dashboard, you will have access to update your own facility – click the grey Update box
- 4.) This reporting is asking you for available beds
  - a. An available bed is empty & staffed
  - b. Monitored means telemetry
